¹ 2015-2016 - (Licensure Rate) Three graduates still working in the field toward licensure. For two of these three, MFT is a secondary career.

² 2016-2017 - (Licensure Rate) Two graduates attained licensure over the last year. Three other graduates are still working in the field toward licensure.

³ 2019-2020 - (Graduation Rate) Two students left the program to pursue different degrees and another withdrew. One student graduated outside of the advertised timeframe.
