Images will also be used for marketing and promotional purposes.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years old; 21 years old preferred.
- Certification in First Aid and CPR.
- Basic understanding of photo/video hardware and programs.
- Knowledge of photo editing software.
- Experience in design, art, or media related field preferred.
- Preferred previous lifeguard, ropes course, and/or summer camp work experience.
- Desire to model Christian values and is actively growing in Christian faith.
- Has interest and experience working with children.
- Is willing to learn and instruct in multiple camp areas.
- Is able to traverse the multi-terrain camp grounds.

Responsibilities:

- Daily take photos and videos of participants.
- Upload photos and videos to NaCoMe's social media accounts and parent portal.
- Create a weekly video for the end of week ceremony.
- Organize and maintain department equipment.
- Assist with all camp programming and other camp-wide activities as assigned.
- Spend time with campers and family groups outside of direct work responsibilities.
- Work as a team with all other NaCoMe staff.
- Perform all other duties as assigned.
