Crime Statistics

The federal law requires that colleges and universities disclose crime statistics on the previous three years for and contain crime data that may occur on-campus, on non-campus property, or on property adjacent to the campus. For the purpose of the Clery Act, any building that is owned or controlled by the institution or is located on property that is owned or controlled by the institution, and is within the reasonably contagious geographic area that makes up the campus is classified by the FBI Uniform Crime Report.
