Job Description

The Director for Discipleship and Worship Ministries will oversee our discipleship ministries (Adult Sunday School, Life Groups and Worship). This role requires a passion for multidirectional discipleship development (recruiting potential leaders, growing new leaders and equipping existing leaders) and practical stewardship (leading and/or participating in key ministry teams, such as, deacon team, finance team, worship team, etc). The right leader will possess a pastoral heart, a passion for gospel ministry, and proven skill in organizational leadership through relationships and timely communication.

Multi-ethnic. Because Cypress is part of the larger Houston metro area, we reflect the diversity of our community. Many of our members are bilingual. It's not uncommon to hear Spanish and even a couple other languages spoken in our lobby. We translate the second service message into Spanish (via headsets). Our membership consists of the following: 12% African-American, 10% Asian, 47% Anglo and 31% Latino.

Christ-centered. We practice consecutive expository preaching, alternating between the Old & New Testaments, and believe that the ultimate aim of each passage is our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We desire our preaching and worship to be Christ-centered. Keeping our hearts and minds focused on Christ helps maintain the unity of the body that the gospel creates between believers.

Gospel-driven. The gospel (not programs) drives our discipleship model of ministry. We use programs, but programs are only helpful to the extent that we are grounding believers into the Gospel.
