- Experience in ministering to diverse groups preferred

- Additional training in counselling or psychiatric conditions preferred
- Additional training related to behaviour management required (may be obtained onsite)

- Conducts funeral or memorial services in support of families
- Continues to expand knowledge by attending appropriate conferences and workshops
- Uses teaching / coaching skills when facilitating educational opportunities
- Provides one-on-one spiritual counsel and support to clients and families during End-of-Life care
- Assesses pastoral needs and acts as a resource to colleagues and managers
- Serves as a facilitator for spiritual care by facilitating the involvement of local ministerial churches in the ministerial service rotations and in other appropriate ways
- Strong listening, communication and interpersonal skills; ability to listen with empathy and to establish and maintain healthy relationships
