

The Boardwalk Chapel
Evangelism Internship
Summer 2025

This full-time paid summer internship is designed to strengthen future ministers in the area of evangelism. The internship includes training and mentorship for the intern, with much opportunity to gain experience in personal evangelism and preaching as well as other aspects of ministry. Responsibilities and mentored experiences of an evangelism intern include:

- Preaching short Gospel sermonettes (1-4 per week) in nightly programs
- Personal Evangelism on the Boardwalk (daily)
- Preaching in the local church on the Lord's Day (2-6 Sundays depending on interest)
- Leading Lord's Day Evening Worship (weekly)
- Leading/Encouraging high school and college age students and other laypeople in evangelism
- Providing spiritual leadership to the summer staff (largely college-age)
- Additional opportunities (based on the interest and gifting of the interns): teaching, administrative tasks, helping with a local children's outreach, etc.
